## Summary

During May and June 2025, Whitewater Township Fire Department (WTFD) responded to 60 calls for service, with valid response times recorded for 57 incidents—excluding those cancelled enroute.

This table reflects all valid June calls where Whitewater Township Fire Department was the responding agency and excludes mutual aid and cancelled enroute responses.

### Impact of Command Availability and On-Call Response Model on Response Times

During the month of June, Chief Morgan was unavailable for emergency response for a period of 10 days. During this time, coverage was maintained through the department's on-call duty crew program. Under this model, firefighters respond from their homes to the station, then proceed to the incident scene with the fire engine. This approach inherently results in longer response times due to the added delay of assembling a crew at the station before deployment. In contrast, when Chief Morgan is available, he typically responds directly from the fire station Monday through Friday during business hours, and from his residence in a designated Chief Command vehicle during evening hours and weekends. This direct-to-scene response significantly improves time-to-arrival, allowing for faster initial size-up, command establishment, and early operational decisions.

Additionally, the department did not receive a monthly response report from Mobile Medical Response (MMR) for May or June, so comparative EMS response times are unavailable. However, anecdotal records from department run sheets indicate that on multiple occasions, WTFD's on-call personnel either arrived on scene ahead of or simultaneously with MMR's staffed ambulance—highlighting the effectiveness of our response model even under on-call conditions.

This operational dynamic—particularly the contrast between staffed and on-call response models—warrants further evaluation. Continued research and analysis should be conducted to determine whether a staffed model for Whitewater Township Fire Department would provide a measurable improvement in emergency response and ultimately be in the best interest of the community.

### Busiest Days

- **May:** Monday & Thursday (6 calls each)
- **June:** Friday (8 calls), Tuesday (7 calls)

### Busiest Hours (Combined)

- Peak call times spanned from 9 AM to 6 PM, with sharp increases at 11 AM, 1 PM, and 5–6 PM.



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## Confirmed Fire Events (June 2025)

1. **June 8** – Boat Fire – On trailer in yard (1.7 min response)
2. **June 21** – Building Fire – Lightning Strike (16.8 min apparatus response)
  - A POV firefighter arrived in under 5 minutes, assessed the scene, and downgraded the incident to non-emergent. This affected the official apparatus response time.

## Summary of Call Type Distribution (May–June 2025)

- EMS Transports - MMR (661):  
May – 12 (46.2%), June – 9 (25%)  
Notable decline in June; may reflect lower EMS demand or faster MMR arrival.
- Alarm Activations – No Fire (745):  
May – 2 (7.7%), June – 7 (19.4%)  
Tripled in June; likely due to detector issues or seasonal occupancy.
- Cancelled Enroute (611):  
June – 4 (11.1%)  
Rise suggests more pre-arrival cancellations or cautious dispatching.
- No Incident Found (622):  
May – 0, June – 3 (8.3%)  
Possibly triggered by false alarms or misreported conditions.

## Additional Notable Trends

- Fire-related calls more than doubled in June, largely due to alarms and minor incidents.
- Over 35% of fire calls were public assists or false alarms—highlighting a need for community education.
- POV responders continue to improve early scene control, though not reflected in official response times.
- WTFD provided key EMS support (lifting, access, packaging), underscoring the value of the on-call program.
- Evening calls (6–11 PM) remained consistently active across both months.

### Code Enforcement

The short-term rental, located at 9276 Elk Lake Trail, is in the hands of our attorney who has sent letters reinforcing our position. Misdemeanor Citation being issued for non-compliance with zoning ordinance Article 4.

#### **4.01 ZONING DISTRICT REGULATIONS**

Except as may otherwise be provided in this ordinance, every building and structure erected, every use of any lot, building, or structure established, every structural alteration or relocation of an existing building or structure occurring, and every enlargement of, or addition to an existing use, building, and structure occurring after the effective date of this ordinance shall be subject to all regulations of this ordinance applicable in the zoning district in which such use, building, or structure is located.

#### **4.02 PRINCIPAL USE REGULATIONS**

This Article identifies the principal land uses permitted in each zoning district. No land use shall be established on a lot or parcel except in conformance with the use regulations provided herein. To minimize potential land use conflicts and advance other purposes as described in Article I, land uses permitted in a particular Zoning District are defined as being a "Use Permitted by Right" or a "Special Land Use" as described hereunder.

- A. Uses Permitted by Right: Uses permitted by right are the primary uses and structures specified for which the district has been established. The Zoning Administrator may approve proposed uses and related structures if all other development standards and requirements contained in this ordinance are met

Pending complaint regarding home-based business on Vinton Road. Working on the application.

Pending complaint regarding home-based business on Elk Lake Road. Per their attorney, paperwork for the planning commission to review the business within the next 30 days.

New complaint regarding three properties on Island View Drive advertising and short-term renting. Short-term renting is not permitted by right in R-1 per Zoning Ordinance Article 4.01, 4.02 and 4.04. Investigating.

Update regarding the blight/nuisance on Skegemog Point Road property. Addressing with the property owner. Property is improving. Property owner stated needs another 30 days or July 25, 2025 to complete.

Complaint on Williamsburg Road regarding scrap pile, carpeting, etc. Property owner is working on it.

Complaint regarding properties on Fairview and Skegemog Point Roads for short-term renting. Investigating.

### **Battle Creek-**

Regarding the flooding: The culvert was cleared by Avery's Excavating. The pond has receded back to normal levels. I am continuing to monitor the intake grate for debris and planning on installing a secondary screen or catch boom. A group of down trees over the path have been cleared.

### **Hi Pray-**

Things are status quo. We are going to crack-fill the tennis courts to prevent further deterioration.

### **Whitewater Township Park and Campground-**

The campground is open and we are staffing from 8am to 9pm with three overlapping shifts. We have completed the painting projects we wanted to get done this year. Within the last two weeks we have seen an increase in campground occupancy and boat launch traffic. We have been working on keeping the trails clear and the autumn olive at bay. The campground has received four 5-star reviews within the last week.

This fall we are upgrading the electrical service on the Pine Needle and Knotty Pine loops, alleviating the current panel and other loops.

*June 30th - August 31st: 578 reservations, 66% occupancy.*

*June 30th - September 28th: 646 reservations, 51% occupancy*

Re: BS&A Upgrade to Cloud

The Treasurer's office has been fully upgraded to BS&A Cloud – all old .NET modules have been converted and the Payment Module has been added. Training has been going well, and the new tax roll for summer 2025 was done using the new cloud module without issue. We balanced with the county and submitted tax bills to Maple River for printing on 6-25-25.

With the new Payment Module, we will now be able take Credit/Debit Card payments for tax bills in the office, and residents will also be able to pay their bills online with ACH or CC/Debit cards directly on the BS&A website. Information and instructions for this new feature were provided on the back of the tax bill.

Deputy Treasurer Andy, has been working with the Park Rangers to help facilitate the set up and training for park employee's on how to use the new Payment Module in order to be able to take credit/debit cards on site at the campground. The hope is to eliminate as many cash transactions as possible and streamline accounting processes.

In addition to preparing for Tax Season and learning a whole new system, we continue to work on preparations for our upcoming Audit in July. We continue to encounter problems with the old accounting software, making it a slow process, but are nearing the end. We are really looking forward to the completion of the BS&A upgrade for all modules so that the workflow will be much more efficient between departments.
